paraphrase of Deuteronomy 32:1-43

1. O heavens, hear! O earth, give ear! Let every soul in awe draw near.
My words shall fall like gentle rain, like morning dew on thirsty grain.
Exalt the Lord! His name is great! His deeds are just, His ways are straight.
